2. Ersyah Amalia (Ersyah)

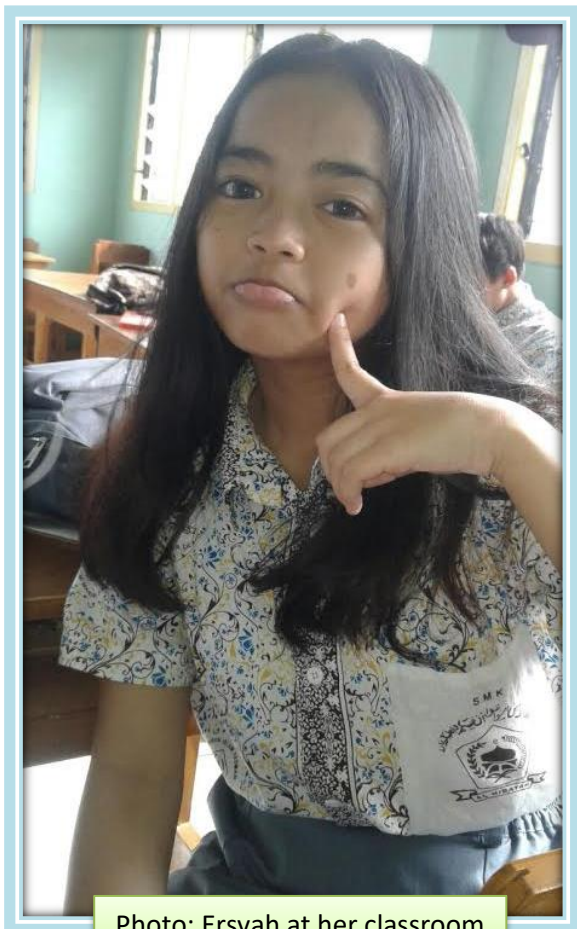

Ersyah is in good health, and twice a year she comes to YUM's office to get a free medical checkup (*see photo*) and the results always good.

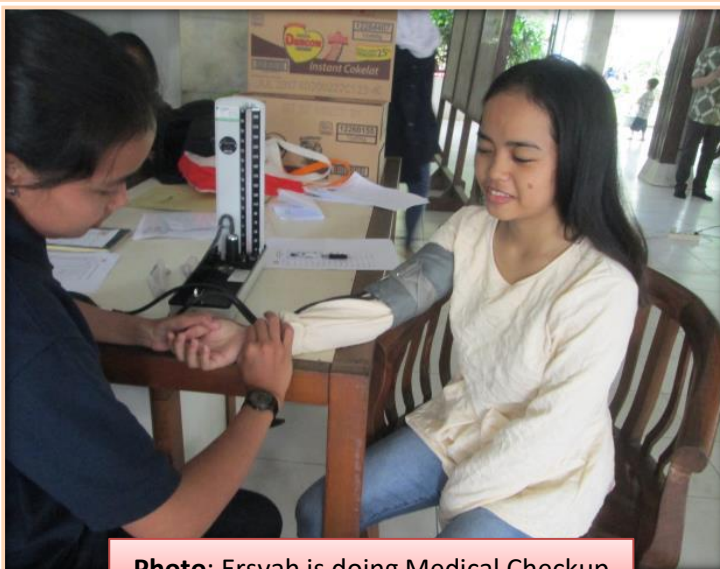
